Organised by the Waste Transformation Research Hub, the Sydney Knowledge Hub, APRU and NSW Circular, ACEC will be held on December 7-11th 2020.

ACEC 2020 will focus on 'design' through the following themes:

- Circular Economy Education
- Construction a Circular Economy Opportunity
- Textiles and Fashion in the Circular Economy
- Circular Economy Entrepreneurship
- Energy-Waste Nexus
- Circular Plastics
- Food Waste in the Circular Economy
- Systems Transparency, Data, Digital and Evidence-based Decisions
- Advancing Manufacturing

If selected your poster will be part of an online session as part of the conference. Expressions of interest close November 27<sup>th</sup>.

A panel of judges will select the top three posters who will also receive awards, prizes to be announced soon.

## **Eligibility:**

- 1) Current or recently graduated Master or PhD student.
- 2) Current Undergraduate students are also welcomed to submit a poster of their final year honours research thesis projects.
- 3) Research presented in a poster must be related to the circular economy within one of the 9 themes highlighted above.
- 4) Students will need to confirm that they have discussed their submission with their thesis supervisor and have obtained supervisor's approval to submit.
- 5) Poster contributions are required to acknowledge all co-authors and contributors of the research displayed in the poster, as well as any funding sources as appropriate.
- 6) Presenters must submit an expression of interest of 100 words or less summarising the work and its relevance to the Circular Economy theme.
