Australia's reliance on landfills necessitates a paradigm shift. The solution lies in waste technology innovations, especially in sustainable waste processing and related policy. The urgency transcends traditional waste disposal; it demands unlocking the latent value within this underused resource. Our mission is to transition towards a Circular Economy, a holistic approach where extraction, production, and end-of-life processing form a closed loop with minimal waste under the utilisation of renewable energy.

The **4th Australian Circular Economy Conference** emerges as a pivotal platform for the fusion of scholarly inquiry and industrial ingenuity. Its foremost objective is to disseminate research breakthroughs and foster dialogues that propel the transition to a circular economy across academic circles, the business sector, governmental bodies, and the wider community.

This biennial conference will be held from **2-4 October 2024** at **The University of Sydney**. The Conference is a three-day event that is expected to attract around 400 participants. It will feature workshops, technical sessions, poster sessions, and keynote speakers from industry leaders and renowned academics and panel discussions.
